


He first made his appearance in 1958, when Canadian Tire introduced its now-famous coupons. He was a creation of Bernie Friedman, a communications assistant with the company. At first Canadian Tire money was available only from the gas bars, but was introduced in the company's stores in 1961.






**QUICK AND EASY RECIPE  
FOR OATMEAL BREAKFAST  
COOKIES**

**Ingredients**

- 1.5 cups quick oats or rolled oats
- 2 medium bananas (ripe)
- 1/3 cup mini chocolate chips
- Optional additions:  
nuts, sprinkle of salt, cinamon



**Instructions**

- Preheat oven to 350F. Line a baking sheet.
- Using the back of a fork, mash the bananas in a medium bowl until they are broken down.
- Add in oats and gently stir until all of the oats and bananas are mixed together (if using rolled oats, let the banana/oat mixture sit for 20 minutes first to absorb better)
- Stir in chocolate chips
- Scoop one heaping tablespoon of the dough into your hands and free form into cookie. Make 10-12 cookies.
- Cook for 12-15 minutes or until set through and lightly golden. Cool and enjoy!

TIP: Don't guess! Use logic and deduction.


